

High school students experience disconnected pathways between education and employment




#### **Braided Structure**

#### **AVC Careers with Children and Families Pathways**


- Earn as you learn career exploration

### **Certifications and College Degrees**

- Earn 12 semester units of transferable college credits while dually enrolled in high school
- Earn an Associate degree in Child and Family Education (CFE) or Sociology (SOC).
- Achieve certifications necessary for permanent work status with public sector employers as well as nonprofit, and public health employers.
- Acquire child development permits issued through the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing



• Early Education Teacher (\$55,000 - \$71,000)

• **Parent-Child Educator** (\$37,000 - \$80,000)

• Early Education Director (\$64,000 - \$81,000)
